COURTESY AND DISCIPLINE

1. The Students are required to respect their teachers and seniors.
2. They must walk on the left in corridors and on staircases.
3. There should be no noise in the classes, while going for games. Pupils should walk in a single line.
4. Pupils must be punctual. They will not be permitted to attend school if they are late.

RULES OF THE SCHOOL

1. All children should come in their school uniform.
2. Dress should be neat, clean and tidy.
3. The students of all classes should attend the prayer in the morning. Late comers will not be admitted to the class without Principal's permission.
4. No pupil should absent himself/herself except for special reasons.
5. Student moving in the corridor must keep silence.
6. No student will be allowed to move in the school playground during class hours.
7. No student should leave the school premises during school hours without the permission of the principal.
8. Punctuality is to be observed.
9. Violation of school rules may be a cause of expulsion of the child.
10. Student should keep their cycles properly locked at the cycle stand. School administration will not be responsible for the loss of bicycle.
11. Classes of L.K.G. & U.K.G will be off on Saturday.
12. All students are expected to speak in English.
13. Discipline must be maintained at any cost.
14. Our students should be polite and disciplined wherever they go. They should always remember that the school is judged by the conduct of its students. They should greet all the teachers whenever and wherever they meet them. Bullying, use of foul language and vulgar behavior will lead to strict action.



RULES FOR ADMISSION

(A) Playgroup, L. K.G. & U. K. G.

1. Admission of a child in pre primary classes is made according to the age and merit of the child.
2. Qualifying in oral test as well as interview is a pre-requisite for gaining admission to playgroup, L.K.G & U. K. G.
3. An oral test for U.K.G. candidates would be conducted. They would have to write simple words in English and Hindi and do simple numerical in mathematics.

(B) PRIMARY (I-V)

1. The minimum age limit for class 1st is 5 years.
2. There will be admission test and an interview for the candidates seeking admission in primary classes. Admission test will be taken in English, Hindi and Maths.

(C) JUNIOR (VI to VIII)

1. Admission to the Junior classes will be permitted only after qualifying a written test and an interview. Written test will be taken in curricular subject i.e. English, Maths, Science and Hindi.

(D) SECONDARY (IX-X)

1. Students must qualify a written test and interview to be selected for admission in class IX. These subjects for written test are English, Science and Hindi.
2. No admission is made for class X.

(E) SENIOR SECONDARY (XI-XI)

1. Admission to class XI after the declaration of results in test in subjects such as English, Maths, Science etc, and on the basis of record in class X and fulfilment of CBSE norms.
2. However no admission is taken in class XII.



House Culture

All the students of RNTSS are divided into four houses, namely Red House (C.V. Raman), Green House (Alfred Nobel), Blue House (S. Radha Krishnan House) and Yellow House (Albert Einstein). This Division provides opportunities for more intimate organizations and for competitions in sport and other activities. Each house is headed by house master, who is responsible for grooming the students with the help of other house leaders and teachers. The system encourages a sense of teamwork and public responsibility and healthy competition.



Co-curricular Activities

Proper arrangements are available for children to take part in Music, Art Dance, Gardening, Needlework, Hobby centers etc. Excursions are arranged relating to cultural, scientific, historical and geographical interest and a planned outdoor programme is organised every year. This helps children to acquire knowledge on direct and personal experience.

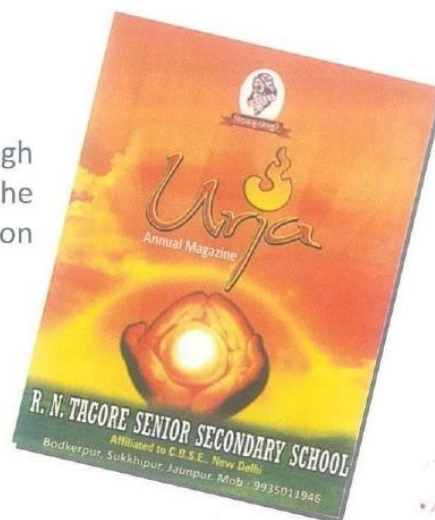


Learning Resource Center

The emphasis of our teaching is on "I do, I learn". In the learning resource Center, the students are given direct experience of acquiring the knowledge of participation in the activities. This helps them in making a sound conceptual base in all subjects like Science, Mathematics, Social Science and Language etc.

Library

The school has a spacious and well stocked library. The students of class I to XII have been provided with a separate library, where books magazines and periodicals, suitable to their age group are provided. Children are encouraged from the very beginning to go to the library and enrich their knowledge. In addition the librarians are available to help and advise on study skills and researching topics in their academic pursuit.



School Transport

The school has a fleet of buses, which covers various routes and other negotiable areas. This facility is available to every nook and corner of the city.



Staff

The staff consists of qualified and skilled teachers most of whom have long experience of work in public school and as such are efficient and experienced to get the best out of the students.



BEFORE SEEKING ADMISSION

1. Two recent stamp size photographs of the student.
2. The admission will be provisional. If transfer certificate and report card are not presented by the guardian in time, the admission stand will be cancelled.
3. At the time of seeking admission all the fees are to be paid, failing which the admission will be null and void.
4. No request will be entertained for refund of fee in the event of withdrawal of the candidate whatever reasons there may be.
5. There shall be no change in the name of wards or date of birth after admission.
6. School authorities will be responsible for the students only during school hours.
7. The guardians are advised to provide correct telephone no., so that they may be called by the school authority as and when required.
8. The guardians are advised not to allow their children to mixup with outsider while coming to school or on way back home.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS



1. Parents are requested to look into their children's diaries everyday and see that their homework assigned for the next day are done regularly.
2. Remarks made in school diary should be seen and countersigned regularly by the parents.
3. If you feel that your ward is not making the desired progress, please make it a point to discuss the matter with the principal during school hours with prior permission of the principal.
4. Visitors are not allowed to meet the teachers in their respective class rooms.
5. Parents must make sure that their children come to school daily and study at least four hours a day at home and keep a good company.
6. Encourage your ward to take a balanced interest in studies, co-curricular activities and sports.
7. 75% attendance is must to appear for the final exam.
